

GENTAMYCIN 10% INJ

Composition:

Contains per ml solution:

Gentamicin (as sulphate) 100 mg

Description:

Gentamicin is an aminoglycoside antibiotic with bactericidal activity against both gram-negative and some gram-positive bacteria.

Indications:

Bacterial infections in horses, cattle, calves, swine, goats and sheep, caused by microorganisms susceptible to gentamicin

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to aminoglycosides. Renal impairment. The product should not be used in pregnant animals.

Dosage and administration:

For intramuscular administration.

Recommended dose: 1 ml per 20 - 25 kg body weight, preferably twice on the first day, followed by once daily for 3 to 5 days.

To avoid underdosing, the body weight of the animals should be determined with accuracy.

Side effects:

Neurotoxicity, ototoxicity and nephrotoxicity, dependent on dosage and duration of treatment.

Interactions:

Do not combine with bacteriostatic antibiotics.

Withdrawal times:

Meat and offal: 45 days

Milk: 5 days

Storage conditions:

Store dark and below 25°C. Do not freeze.

Packing:

100 ml vials.
